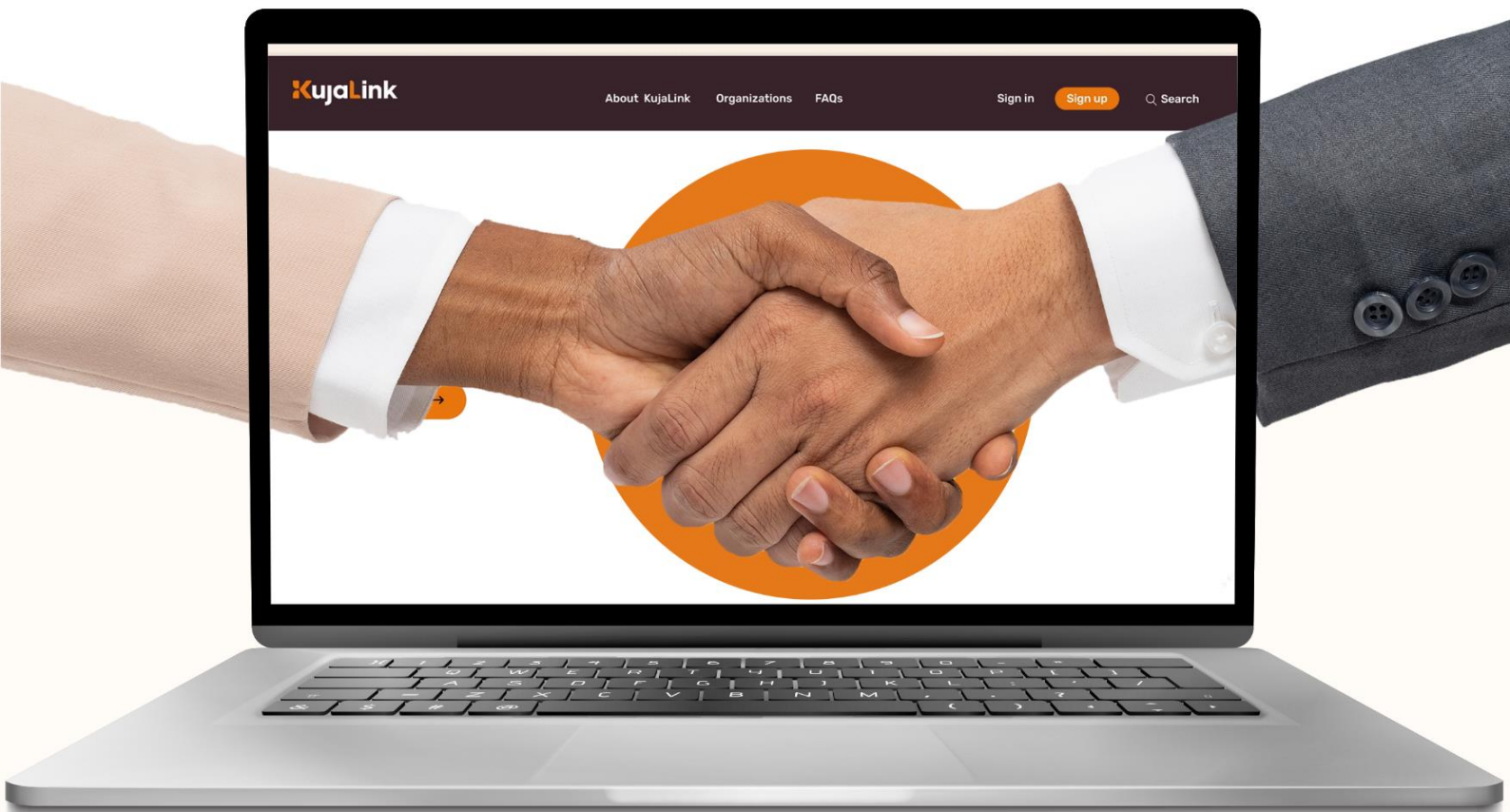

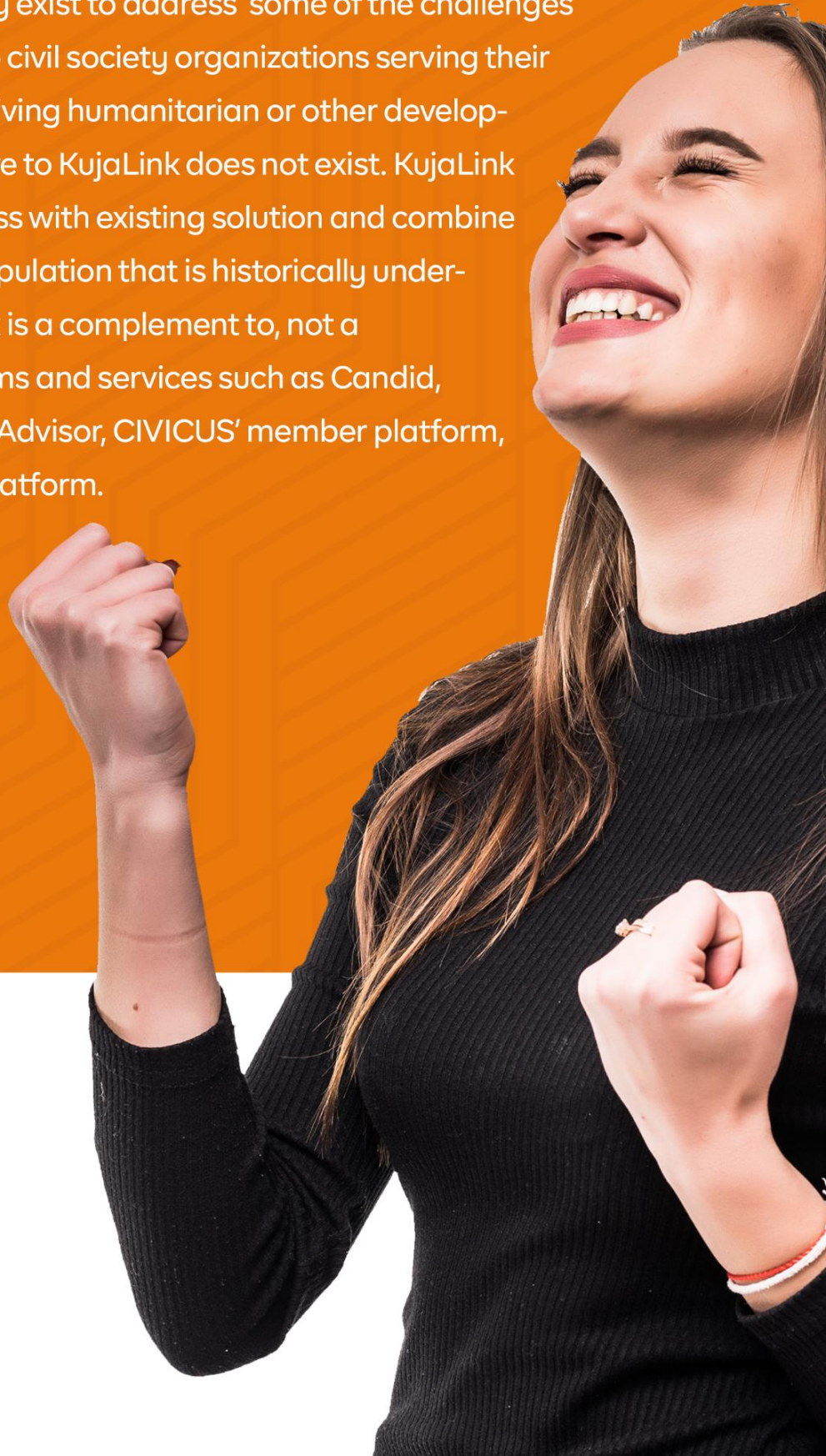
About kujalink

Our Achievements

While many solutions currently exist to address some of the challenges to increasing direct funding to civil society organizations serving their communities in countries receiving humanitarian or other development assistance, an alternative to KujaLink does not exist. KujaLink has taken an important process with existing solution and combine them to bring services to a population that is historically underserved and excluded. KujaLink is a complement to, not a replacement for other platforms and services such as Candid, Guidestar, NGO Source, GrantAdvisor, CIVICUS' member platform, and NEAR's South-to-South platform.

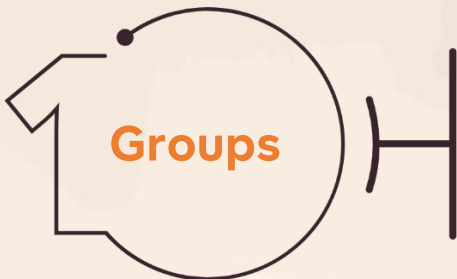
ADESO - African Development Solutions
